Abstract - Template



Accepted abstracts for the NSC will be submitted for publication in the *Anaesthesia and Intensive Care* (AAIC) journal. Therefore, all abstracts must comply with journal requirements, including:

- Abstracts MUST include ethics approval number, the name of the ethics committee providing approval, clinical trials registry (if applicable), patient/participant consent (if applicable), and any conflicts of interest (personal, financial, or professional). If no ethics approval was obtained, please provide reasoning why.
- Abstracts without the above information will be judged ineligible, unless the project does not involve patient or participant recruitment
- Figures and tables are not permitted
- Abstracts cannot be published if previously published in a journal

Abstracts for prize sessions will have the following extra requirements:

- The presenting author must be an ASA member. If the presenter is an ASA Trainee Member, a full ASA member who is part of the research team must also be present at the Prize Session, but does not contribute to the presentation or subsequent question & answer session.
- A research group is eligible to submit more than one abstract for consideration for prize sessions, but both the first author and the presenter for each accepted abstract must be different

Title of abstract in sentence case

Example: This is the title of the abstract

Authors separated by semicolon, Full first and surname, followed by affiliation, country

Example: Jane Smith, Australian Society of Anaesthetists, Australia; Jim Jones, New Zealand Society of Anaesthetists, New Zealand

Abstract to include the following subheadings (600 words maximum including references)

Introduction: include the aim of the project

Methods: a statement on ethics and clinical trials registration MUST be included

Results: Text only

Discussion: include a conclusion

Conflicts of interest: if applicable

References: maximum 3, use square brackets with numerals eg. [1], [1-2]
